Oughtibridge War Memorial Women FC

Oughtibridge War Memorial Women FC were formed in 2013 and quickly established themselves as one of the top teams in South Yorkshire by winning successive promotions from the Sheffield and Hallamshire County League along with League Cup doubles. Moving up in standard they then won promotion from the North East Regional League Southern Division, finishing ahead of Sheffield Wednesday Ladies, and have since played at regional level, now in the East Midlands Regional Premier League. The standard is high with the Women travelling to play the likes of Northampton Town, Peterborough United, Notts County, Rotherham United and Mansfield Town, so silverware is now hard to come by although they did win the League Plate final in 2021 overcoming the talented Loughborough University students 3-2 in the final. They have also been Sheffield and Hallam County Cup semi finalists on 3 occasions but have lost out to semi pro outfits Sheffield FC, Barnsley and Huddersfield Town. Younger players have been promoted from the exciting under 18s team to bring some fresh impetus into the club and whilst league results have been hard to come by this season there was some respite in the FA cup where they overcame York and Notts Trent University on their way to a glamour tie against Nottingham Forest Women, which attracted a large crowd but ultimately a defeat. John Camm, on behalf of Forest, tweeted *"thank you for the warm welcome, all club's should be like yours, you are a real credit to your village and the game"*
